


## VICTORIA UNIVERSITY OF WELLINGTON

## CIRP -VUW PSYCHOLOGY TRANSFER PATH

CIRP offers an excellent pathway to study psychology at the prestigious Victoria University of Wellington through CIRP's New Zealand Psychology Transfer program.

Students are able to study (01) one or (02) two years at CIRP in Sri Lanka and enter the Bachelor's degree program in Psychology at VUW, New Zealand. Students will complete either 120 credits in one year or 240 credits in two years of their psychology program at CIRP in Sri Lanka and transfer into the 2nd of the 3rd year of the psychology degree offered by VUW in New Zealand.

CIRP –VUW Psychology transfer pathway is the only pathway in Sri Lanka that offers 100% credit transfer to New Zealand. Students are able to progress through their studies without having to study or pay for bridging modules

2. You are able to save up to 40% of the course fee through the transfer pathway, by completing one or two years in Sri Lanka.

3. You will be living and studying in Wellington, the capital city of New Zealand with ample opportunities for part time work during your studies.

4. You will be graduating with a psychology degree, one of the most demanded fields of work in New Zealand, opening many opportunities in New Zealand.

5. You are eligible for post-study work visa, where you could be employed in New Zealand after you have completed your psychology degree.



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



#### Can I work while I study?

New Zealand's work rights for international students are among the best in the world. You can gain experience and skills working in New Zealand during and after your studies.

University's Careers and Employment team can help you with career advice, preparing your CV, and finding a job. Talk to them when you start looking for work—they have great recommendations for international students.

Your student visa may allow you to work part time (up to 20 hours per week) during the academic year and full time (up to 40 hours per week) during scheduled breaks in study and during the Christmas and New Year holiday period.

#### Can I work in New Zealand after I finish my degree?

New Zealand's new post-study work visa allows graduates with a Bachelor's degree or higher to stay and work in New Zealand for up to three years.

Working in New Zealand is the perfect opportunity to build your future career using the networks and skills you have gained during your studies.



# PROCESS & CIRP SUPPORT

1. You enter the international psychology degree transfer program at CIRP after completing your A/L or O/L qualifications. Students after A/L enter the degree 1st year and the students after O/L enter the Foundation course.

2. If you prefer to transfer after (01) year, you will complete 8 modules and gain 120 credits in Psychology. You are able to enter the 2nd year of the Psychology degree at VUW, New Zealand.

3. If you prefer to transfer after (02) years, you will complete 16 modules and gain 240 credits in Psychology. You are able to enter the 3rd year of the psychology degree at VUW, New Zealand.

4. CIRP's international admissions team will work with you from the beginning to prepare you for the university admissions and to meet the visa requirements.

5. CIRP will provide you with IELTS training and support with improving your language and academic skills for you to become successful at VUW.


6. CIRP international admissions staff will guide you with regard to the university application process, obtain the offer letter and prepare you for the visa interview.
