TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIPS



Merit based scholarships are awarded to students who have excelled in their studies at Government and London O/L and A/L examinations achieving outstanding results. Based on the results of the applicants, scholarships will be awarded to the ones with the highest grades.



Sports based scholarships are awarded to students who have performed exceptionally in sports at National, Provincial and School level. Scholarships are open to sportsmen and women from both solo and team sports.



Aesthetic talents based scholarships are allocated for students who have significant achievements in singing, dancing, playing musical instruments, drama and art & design. Students who have significant achievements in these areas are encouraged to apply.



Leadership scholarships are also awarded for demonstrating leadership at school and community level. Students who have been prefects, presidents and executive members of clubs and societies of schools and community organizations have the opportunity to apply under this category.

Conditions

Scholarship covers the course fee (inclusive of tuition and examination fees) but not other expenses such as living expenses, accommodation and/ or airfare. Percentage of the course fee covered would vary from 100% (Full Scholarship) or between 100% and 40% (Partial Scholarships) based on the availability of the allocated funds. For the partial Scholarships the percentage of funding will be determined by the Committee on the basis of student's achievements and may vary case to case.

Application Process

1. Obtaining an Application

Candidates who are interested in applying for any of the scholarships should contact CIRP (Email :scholarships@cirp.lk / WhatsApp : +94 070 341 8001 / Telephone : 0117 212 333 / 0117 212 999) and request for the link for the online scholarship form before the deadline. You will be send the link within 24 hours.

2. Submission of Completed Online Application

Completed application form along with the supporting documents should be submitted before the submission deadline. If there is an issue uploading the supporting documents, candidates could email them to scholarships@cirp.lk Upon submitting the scholarship application , you will receive an acknowledgement email as proof of submission.

3. Interview

Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee. Candidates will be evaluated based on their answers for a standard set of questions based on the type of the scholarship. Based on the scoring received for the application form and the points scored at the interview, the panel will index the recipients based on the total.

4. Notification

Candidates who are chosen for the scholarships will be notified and will be given seven (07) days to confirm the acceptance of their scholarship. Upon accepting the scholarship the candidate will be send information for registration and enrollment for the particular program. Scholarship officer will guide you through the process.
